WHO CAN BE A PROVISIONAL MEMBER?

Provisional Membership is covered in Chapter 3 Article 3 of the WASLI Governing Document:

PROVISIONAL MEMBERS are those interpreters from a country where there is no national association of sign language interpreters. The Provisional Member will have no vote.

The Provisional Member must provide a working plan toward the development of a national association. This plan must be received and accepted by the WASLI Executive Board before being allowed to join as a Provisional Member.

WHAT DOCUMENTS DOES WASLI NEED?

There are a number of documents that need to accompany this application. Please attach the following:

(a) A copy of the PLAN to become a National Association which includes a list of all interpreters working together to become a National Association with their contact details

(b) A letter of support from your national Deaf Association signed by the President with their official stamp.
